

ANTS 2026 - Camera-Ready Author Checklist

Before submitting your camera-ready paper, please verify **all** items below.

Failure to meet these requirements may result in exclusion from the conference proceedings.

1. Template and formatting

- I prepared my paper using the [LNCS Springer LaTeX template](#).
- I did **not modify** llncs.cls or splncs04.bst .
- I did **not override** template defaults (margins, spacing, font sizes).
- I did **not use** formatting hacks (e.g. \vspace{}, custom fonts, subcaption).

2. Page limits

- My paper respects the correct page limit:
 - Full paper: **≤ 11 pages + references**
 - Short paper: **≤ 7 pages + references**
 - Extended abstract: **≤ 2 pages (including references)**
- Figures, tables, and acknowledgements are included **within** the page limit.
- I did **not** modify formatting to artificially reduce page count.

3. LNCS formatting details

Running header

- I enabled running headers using
`\documentclass[runningheads]{llncs}`
- `\authorrunning{}` follows LNCS rules (first author always included).
- `\titlerunning{}` is provided if the title is long.

Title and headings

- Title and headings use **Title Case** capitalization (i.e., all words should be capitalized, except for articles, prepositions, and conjunctions).
- I did **not** use `\newline` in the title.
- Headings are left-aligned.

Authors and affiliations

- Full first names are used (no initials only).
- No academic titles are included (e.g. Prof., Dr.).
- Affiliations include department, institution, city, country, and email.
- The corresponding author's email is included.
- `\index{}` entries are provided for all authors. For example:

```
\index{SurnameAuthor1, FirstnameAuthor1}
\index{SurnameAuthor2, FirstnameAuthor2}
\index{SurnameAuthor3, FirstnameAuthor3}
```

ORCIDs are included if desired (optional).

Extended abstracts (if applicable)

No abstract is included.
 No section headings appear in the main body.
 Only **References** and **Acknowledgements** headings are used (if applicable).

4. Figures

Figures are provided in **vector format** (`.pdf` , `.eps`) where possible.
 Raster figures meet resolution requirements:

- ≥ 800 dpi (linework)
- ≥ 300 dpi (other figures)

All figures remain legible when printed in **grayscale**.

5. References and bibliography

The following lines are present and uncommented in my manuscript:

```
\bibliographystyle{splncs04}
\bibliography{mybibliography}
```

I did **not** change the bibliography configuration.
 I created a `.bib` file and populated it with all references.
 My `.bib` file is named `mybibliography.bib`, **or** I updated the filename used in the `\bibliography{...}` command accordingly.
 I generated the `.bbl` file and included it in the submission archive.

6. Supplementary video (only if accepted via decision email)

- My paper was explicitly notified (in the decision email) as having an **accepted supplementary video**.
- I included the video in the submission archive and it meets all requirements:
 - MP4 format only
 - Max duration: **180 seconds**
 - Max file size: **50 MB**
 - Format: **16:9**
- I understand **no late videos are allowed**: a video not submitted with the initial paper submission will **not** be accepted later.
- The video does not violate privacy/confidentiality and I obtained permission for any third-party content.

(If you did **not** have an accepted video:

- I did **not** include any video.)

7. Files to submit

I prepared **one compressed archive** (`.zip` or `.tgz`) containing:

- Compiled PDF (`.pdf`)
- Main LaTeX file (`.tex`)
- Bibliography files (`.bib` and `.bbl`)
- All figures (in original formats)
- Completed Camera-Ready Author Checklist (`.pdf`)
- Supplementary video (`.mp4`) **only if accepted**

The archive contains **only files required for compilation** (no unused/old figures, backups, or previous manuscript versions).

The archive's size does not exceed 100MB.

The PDF matches the compiled LaTeX sources exactly.

The paper compiles **without errors**.

8. Submission and registration

I uploaded the archive via **EasyChair → Add or update files**.

At least one author is **registered** for the conference.

At least one author will **attend and present** the paper.

9. Copyright

The Springer **Consent-to-Publish form** is completed and signed.

The form includes all required information.

The form was emailed to ants2026@rcps.tu-darmstadt.de using the correct subject line.
